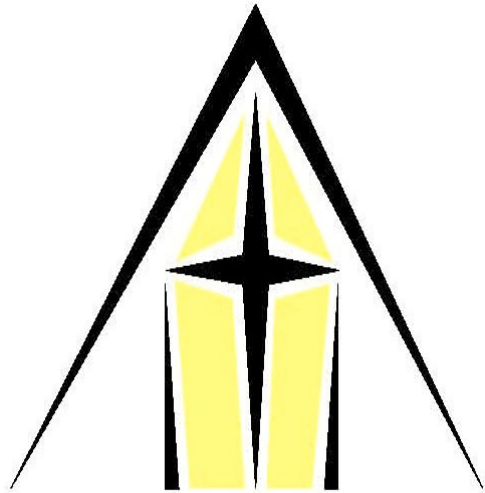

**Stained Glass Window** The last stained glass window commissioned at this time was placed in the West window in the entryway. This window represents the Gospel writer St. Mark after whom the congregation was named. St. Mark was an assistant to the Apostle Paul. The lion represents courage. The wings represent speed and urgency. The Word of God is in his hand. What a fitting symbol for our congregation! With courage and urgency we proclaim the Word of God to the world. It is placed by the main entryway door to the church to remind us as we leave that we are to go forth with courage and urgency and tell others about the good news of our Savior. Since this window symbolizes the whole congregation, it has been suggested that the congregation as a whole cover the cost and that everyone who desires makes a donation to it above and beyond their normal offerings.
