Thursday, Aug 21	Genesis 1:1 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.
Friday, Aug 22	Psalms 139:14 I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well.
Tuesday, Aug 26	2 <sup>nd</sup> Article: I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and buried. He descended into hell. The third day he rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty. From there he will come to judge the living and the dead.
Thursday, Aug 28	2 <sup>nd</sup> Article meaning: What does this mean? I believe that Jesus Christ, true God, begotten from the father from eternity, and also true man, born of the virgin Mary, is my Lord. He has redeemed me, a lost and condemned creature,
Wednesday, Sept 3	More 2 <sup>nd</sup> Article Meaning: purchased and won me from all sins, from death, and from the power of the devil, not with gold or silver, but with his holy, precious blood, and with his innocent suffering and death.
Friday, Sept 5	Genesis 8:21 Every inclination of [man's] heart is evil from childhood.
Tuesday, Sept 9	Rest of 2 <sup>nd</sup> article meaning: All this he did that I should be his own, and live under him in his kingdom, and serve him in everlasting righteousness, innocence and blessedness, just as he has risen from death and lives and rules eternally. This is most certainly true..
Thursday, Sept 11	Hebrews 11:1 Now faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see.
Tuesday, Sept 16	Psalms 50:15 Call upon me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you and you will honor me.
Thursday, Sept 18	Proverbs 3:5 Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding.
Friday, Sept 19	Hymn 234 v.1 Praise to the Lord, the Almighty, the Kind of creation! O my soul, praise him, for he is your health and salvation Let all who hear now to his temple draw near, Joining in glad adoration!
Tuesday, Sept 23	3 <sup>rd</sup> Article: I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Holy Christian Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.
Thursday, Sept 25	3 <sup>rd</sup> Article Meaning: What does this mean? I believe that I can not by my own thinking or choosing because in my Lord Jesus Christ, or come to him. But the Holy Spirit has called me by the gospel, enlightened me with his gifts, sanctified and kept me

	in the one true faith.
Friday, Sept 26	Hymn 411 v.1 What a friend we have in Jesus, All our sins and griefs to bear! What a privilege to carry everything to God in prayer! Oh, what peace we often forfeit, Oh what needless pain we bear, all because we do not carry everything to God in prayer!
Tuesday, Sept 30	More 3 <sup>rd</sup> Article meaning: In the same way he calls, gathers, enlightens and sanctifies the whole Christian church on earth, and keeps it with Jesus Christ in the one true faith. In this Christian church he daily and fully forgives all sins to me and all believers. On the last day he will raise me and all the dead and give eternal live to me and all believers in Christ. This is most certainly true.
Thursday, Oct 2	8 <sup>th</sup> Commandment: You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor. What does this mean? We should fear and love God that we do not tell lies about our neighbor, betray him, or give him a bad name, but defend him, speak well of him, and take his words and actions in the kindest possible way.
Thursday, Oct 9	10 <sup>th</sup> Commandment: You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, workers, animals, or anything that belongs to your neighbor. What does this mean? We should fear and love God that we do not force or entice away our neighbor's spouse, workers, or animals, but urge them to stay and do their duty.
Friday, Oct 10	Hymn 429 v.1 What God ordains is always good; His will is just and holy. As he directs my life for me, I follow meek and lowly. My God indeed in every need knows well how he will shield me, To him, then I will yield me.
Tuesday, Oct 14	Romans 8:28 And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose.
Thursday, Oct 16	Matthew 26:41 Watch and pray so that you will not fall into temptation. The spirit is willing but the body is weak.
Friday, Oct 17	Hymn 478 v.1 With the Lord begin your task; Jesus will direct it. For his aid and counsel ask; Jesus will perfect it. Ev'ry morn with Jesus rise, and, when day is ended, In his name then close your eye; be to him commended.
Tuesday, Oct 21	Psalm 56:11 In God I trust; I will not be afraid. What can man do to me?
Thursday, Oct 23	Lord's Prayer: Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us today our daily bread. Forgive us our sins, as we forgive those who sin against us. Lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For the kingdom, the power, and the glory are yours now and forever. Amen.
Tuesday, Oct 28	5 <sup>th</sup> Commandment: You shall not murder. What does this mean? We should fear and love God that we do not hurt or

Tuesday, Nov 4	Ephesians 4:23 Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.
Thursday, Nov 6	4 <sup>th</sup> Commandment: Honor your father and mother, that it may go well with you and that you may enjoy a long life on the earth. What does this mean? We should fear and love God that we do not dishonor or anger our parents and others in authority, but honor, serve, and obey them, and give them love and respect.
Friday, Nov 7	Hymn 200 A mighty fortress is our God, A trusty shield and weapon; He helps us free from ev'ry need that has us now o'ertaken The old evil foe Now means deadly woe; Deep guile and great might are his dread arms in fight; on Earth is not his equal .
Tuesday, Nov 11	I John 3:15 Anyone who hates his brother is a murderer, and you know that no murderer has eternal life in him.
Thursday, Nov 13	1 <sup>st</sup> Commandment: You shall have no other gods. What does this mean? We should fear, love and trust in God above all things.
Friday, Nov 14	Hymn 613 v1 Come you thankful people, come; Raise the song of harvest home. All be safely gathered in ere the winter storms begin. God our make shall provide for our wants to be supplied. Come to God's own temple, come, raise the song of harvest home.
Tuesday, Nov 18	Psalms 14:1 The fool says in his heart, "There is no God."
Thursday, Nov 20	The Conclusion: What does God say about all these commandments? He says, "I the Lord your God am a jealous God, punishing the children for the sin of the father to the third and fourth generation of those who hate me, but showing love to the thousands who love me and keep my commandments."
Friday, Nov 21	Hymn 432 v.1 I am Jesus' little lamb; ever glad at hear I am, for my shepherd gently guides me, knows my needs and well provides me, loves me everyday the same, even calls me by my name.
Tuesday, Nov 25	Matthew 10:28 Do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. Rather, be afraid of the One who can destroy both soul and body in hell.

Tuesday, Jan 6	John 3:16 For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.

Tuesday, Jan 13	Job 19:25-27 I know that my Redeemer lives, and that in the end he will stand upon the earth. And after my skin has been destroyed, yet in my flesh I will see God; I myself will see him with my own eyes—I and not another. How my heart yearns

Thursday, Jan 15	Isaiah 41:10 Do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.
Wednesday, Jan 21	9 <sup>th</sup> Commandment: You shall not covet your neighbor's house. What does this mean? We should fear and love God that we do not scheme to get our neighbor's inheritance or house, or obtain it by a show or right, but do all we can to help him keep it.
Friday, Jan 23	More Conclusion Meaning: God threatens to punish all who transgress these commandments. Therefore we should fear his anger and not disobey what he commands. But he promises grace and every blessing to all who keep these commandments. Therefore we should love and trust in him and gladly obey what he commands.
Tuesday, Jan 27	1 Corinthians 10:31 Whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God.
Thursday, Jan 29	2 <sup>nd</sup> Commandment: You shall not misuse the name of the Lord your God. What does this mean? We should fear and love God that we do not use his name to curse, swear, lie or deceive, or use witchcraft, but call upon God's name in every trouble, pray, praise and give thanks.
Friday, Jan 30	Hymn 391 v.1 God loved the world so that he gave His only Son the lost to save that all who would in him believe should everlasting life receive.
Thursday, Feb 5	6 <sup>th</sup> Commandment: You shall not commit adultery. What does this mean? We should fear and love God that we lead a pure and decent life in words and actions, and that husband and wife love and honor each other.
Tuesday, Feb 10	1 <sup>st</sup> Article: I believe in God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth. What does this mean? I believe that God created me and all that exists, and that he gave me my body and soul, eyes, ears and all my members, my mind and all my abilities.
Thursday, Feb 12	1 <sup>st</sup> Article more meaning: And I believe that God still preserves me by richly and daily providing clothing and shoes, food and drink, house and home, spouse and children, land, cattle, and all I own, and all I need to keep my body and life. God also preserves me by defending me against all danger, guarding and protecting me from all evil.
Friday, Feb 13	Hymn 609 We praise you, O God, our Redeemer, Creator In grateful devotion our tribute we bring: we lay it before you; we kneel and adore you; we bless your holy name; glad praises we sing.
Wednesday, Feb 18	1 <sup>st</sup> Article more meaning: All this God does only because he is my good and merciful Father in heaven, and not because I have earned or deserved it. For all this I ought to thank and praise, to serve and obey him. This is most certainly true.

Friday, Feb 20	3 <sup>rd</sup> Commandment: Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy. What does this mean? We should fear and love God that we do not despise preaching and his Word, but regard it as holy, and gladly hear and learn it.
Tuesday, Feb 24	Proverbs 22:6 Train a child in the way he should go, and when he is old he will not turn from it.
Thursday, Feb 26	Proverbs 13:24 He who spares the rod hates his son, but he who loves him is careful to discipline him.
Tuesday, March 3	7 <sup>th</sup> Commandment: You shall not steal. What does this mean? We should fear and love God that we do not take our neighbor's money or property, or get it by dishonest dealing, but help him to improve and protect his property and means of income.
